Notes:

1. April reflected a \$4,647 loss month as revenues dropped off significantly to \$6,800 from almost \$20,000 in the month prior and compared to just over \$27,000 for March 2010. As a result, YTD revenues have slipped by \$4,500 behind budget. This is entirely a result of lower fundraising revenues as dues are slightly ahead YTD budget. To meet budgeted revenues by FYE, May revenues will need to exceed \$10,000 for the month.
2. Other revenues YTD include \$6,000 in dumpster income, which is also at budgeted amounts. This amount is more of a “draw” of actual dumpster revenues of approximately \$ 13,000. As the dumpster LLC is a disregarded tax entity, final income and expense adjustments are made at FYE.
3. WFPA cash balances that increased by almost \$15,000 in March, were reduced by \$12,800 in April as a result the purchase of the CAFS unit (\$8,000), and firefighter equipment purchases (\$4,551).
4. Remaining commitments for previously approved SCBA expenses and the remainder of the consultant fee are \$4,200 and \$2,500 respectively.
