Procurement

Our new SCBAs finally arrived. We now have six Avon SCBAs. The old MSA SCBAs are now out of service. Having just one type of SCBA will make things much simpler. The MSAs are so old that selling them could be problematic, even giving them away would prudently require a disclaimer absolving us of any harm. Does the board want to give direction on their disposition?

We purchased a very hearty Sawzall for vehicle extrication. This is a much safer and faster option for removing a vehicle windshield versus using a fire ax with a technique that looks like using a manual can opener. A much smaller outlay went toward several pairs of extrication gloves (they are resistant to cuts/punctures from anything sharp) and they immediately

came in handy on the rollover call we had. The point is not that you want to micromanage small purchases but that as we learn more and get more training we will find other equipment gaps that would be wise for us to fill.

Grants

We have applied for the 2020 VFA grant administered by the state which goes toward wildland fire PPE. In the past this has been an easier grant to get, we can have no expectation that will always be the case.

 Firewise - Loren Bykerk – Things have been slow – 2020 renewal has been accepted – Chip and Haul – we do not have a budget for this yet.
